Diana Noble will talk about her personal career path from pure commercial, to pure impact and finally a combination of the two, in order to draw out themes she hopes will be relevant and interesting to the audience.

Diana started in PE in 1987; she was a partner at Schroder Ventures (now Permira) for 12 years and then was founder CEO of e-Ventures and Reed Elsevier Ventures. She made the jump to the Clinton Foundation's Health Access Initiative in 2006, where she oversaw the scale-up of a global program to give children access to HIV/AIDS care and treatment.

She then took on the CEO role at CDC, the UK's £5 billion development finance institution, investing to support the building of businesses throughout Africa and South Asia and led a turnaround and growth strategy from 2011 to 2017.

She now has a portfolio of Board seats (Bank of England and MedAccess) and a nascent advisory business (Kirkos Partners) helping leaders of PE firms with key organisational challenges, such as planning and executing leadership succession.
